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We begin and end story time with special songs to create a sense of community.

The Hello Song gets us ready to pay attention to the books and other activities. Our Hello Song is titled:

Bread and Butter

Continue with other ways to say Hello: high, low, fast, slow, and nicely.

Story Time each week consists of reading aloud a couple of books related to the theme and singing songs and doing finger plays and action rhymes. Sometimes there are flannel board stories too.

The red bags are logged in and rotated so each child who has returned the bag gets to take home a new bag with three different books inside.

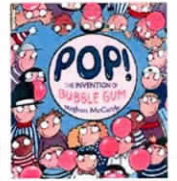

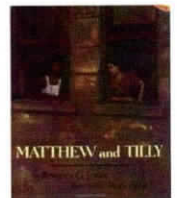
